### “Be” verbs (present)

|-----------------|---------------------|------------------|
| I am...         | I am not...         | Am I...?         |
| You are...      | You are not...      | Are you...?      |
| He/She/It is... | He/She/It is not... | Is he/she/it...? |
| We are...       | We are not...       | Are we...?       |
| They are...     | They are not...     | Are they...?     |

### Vocabulary: Pronouns and possessives

| I    | My    | Me   | Mine   |
| You  | Your  | You  | Yours  |
| He   | His   | Him  | His    |
| She  | Her   | Her  | Hers   |
| We   | Our   | Us   | Ours   |
| They | Their | Them | Theirs |

| I am a doctor.          | You are a doctor.        | He is a doctor.           |
| My friend is a doctor.  | Your friend is a doctor. | His friend is a doctor.   |
| My friend likes me.     | My friend likes you.     | My friend likes him.      |
| This car is mine.       | This car is yours.       | This car is his.          |
| She is a doctor.        | We are doctors.          | They are doctors.         |
| Her friend is a doctor. | Our friend is a doctor.  | Their friend is a doctor. |
| My friend likes her.    | My friend likes us.      | My friend likes them.     |
| This car is hers.       | This car is ours.        | This car is theirs.       |
