He/She/It has...	He/She/It doesn't have...	Does he/she/it have...?
We have...	We don't have...	Do we have...?
They have...	They don't have...	Do they have...?

Expressions to describe a place:

My neighborhood **has** many restaurants. / a big park. / a traditional market.

My neighborhood **is** busy/loud/calm/clean.

There is a park. / a hospital. / a bakery.

There are many cafes. / two schools. / many playgrounds.

I **can** (do) something in my neighborhood.

I **can** exercise at the park.

I **can** meet friends and eat delicious food in my neighborhood, because **there are** many good restaurants.

It is famous for (something).

Hongdae **is famous for** (nightlife/street performers/having many bars and clubs).

Korea **is famous for** (kimchee).

Las Vegas **is famous for** (gambling/casinos/amazing shows).
