Expressions:

Asking for suggestion/ideas:

Giving suggestion/ideas:

I think... In my opinion... I believe...

I (strongly/really) recommend/suggest (something).

Supporting your idea with conditionals:

If we (do) something, (something) will/can happen. If we (did) something, (something) would/could happen.
