

## **The 4 Conditionals:**

### **The Zero Conditional: General truths and general habits**

(if + present simple, ... present simple)

If you heat water to 100 degrees, it boils.

### **The First Conditional: Possible or likely things in the future**

(if + present simple, ... will + infinitive)

If it rains tomorrow, we'll go to the cinema.

### **The Second Conditional: Impossible things in the present/unlikely things in the future**

(if + past simple, ... would + infinitive)

If I had a lot of money, I would travel around the world.

### **The Third Conditional: Things that didn't happen in the past and their imaginary results**

(if + past perfect, ... would + have + past participle)

If I had gone to bed early, I would have caught the train.
