



### Giving preference:

I prefer (something) to (something).  
I prefer (to do/doing something).  
I would rather (do something) than (do something).  
I like (something) more than (something).

### Comparatives:

(More/Less + adjective) or ( adjective + -er)

Big - Bigger  
Small - Smaller  
Smart - Smarter

Beautiful - More/Less beautiful  
Charming - More/Less charming  
Stressed - More/Less stressed

Good - Better  
Bad - Worse

### Example:

1. Do you prefer cats or dogs?

I prefer (cats) to (dogs).  
I like (cats) more than (dogs).

Why?

Cats are **cuter** than dogs.  
Cats are **more independent** than dogs.  
Cats are **smarter** than dogs.

2. Do you prefer to watch TV or read a book?

I would rather (watch TV) than (read a book.)  
I like (watching TV) more than (reading a book.)

Why?

Watching TV is **more relaxing**.  
Reading a book is **more boring** than watching TV.  
TV is **more entertaining** than reading a book.
