



Giving preference:

I prefer (something) to (something).

I prefer (pizza) to (hamburgers).

I prefer (to do/doing something).

I prefer (watching movies) to reading books.

I would rather (do something) than (do something).

I would rather (stay home) than (go to work).

I like (something) more than (something).

I like (summer) more than (winter).

Comparatives:

(More/Less + adjective) or (adjective + -er)

Big - Bigger

Small - Smaller

Smart - Smarter

Beautiful - More/Less beautiful

Charming - More/Less charming

Stressed - More/Less stressed

Good - Better

Bad - Worse

Examples:

I prefer (salads) to (hamburgers), because salads are **healthier**.

I prefer (watching movies) to reading books, because it's **more interesting**.

I would rather (stay home) than (go to work), because it's **less stressful**.

I like (summer) more than (winter), because summer is **more beautiful**.
