

# PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS:

---

## STRUCTURE:

I/You/We/They	have been + -ing	I/You/We/They	have not been + -ing haven't been + -ing
He/She /It/John	has been + -ing	He/She /It/John	has not been + -ing hasn't been + -ing
QUESTIONS:			
Have	I/You/We/They	been + -ing?	Yes, I have. No, we haven't.
Has	He/She /It/John	been + -ing?	Yes, he has. No, she hasn't.

---

## USE:

- Past action that is still ongoing (emphasize duration)
- Finished action that influence the present
- Signal words: all (day/week/life,etc)/the whole day/how long/for/since/recently/these days

### Examples:

I have been studying English since middle school.

I have been trying to fix the TV for 1 hour.

He has been sleeping all day.

He has been playing baseball all his life.

She hasn't been studying much recently.

She has been working overtime these days.

They have been fighting a lot these days.

They haven't been living together for a long time.

We haven't been eating junk food for a month.

We have been playing video games for 2 hours.

It has been raining all day.

Work hasn't been easy these days.

How long have you been living here?

How long has she been driving?
