I/You/We/They/He/ She/It	will (do)	will not (do) won't (do)
QUESTIONS:		
Will	I/You/We/They/He/She/It	(do)?
		Yes, I will. No, I won't.
I	am going to (do)	am not going to (do)
He/She/lt/John	is going to (do)	is not going to (do) isn't going to (do)
You/They/We	are going to (do)	are not going to (do) aren't going to (do)
QUESTIONS:	•	•
Am	I	going to (do)?
Is	he/she/it/John	going to (do)?
Are	you/they/we	going to (do)?
		Yes, I am. No, I am not.

USE

- 1. To show an action that will occur in the future
- 2. To express intention or promise
- 3. To express a prediction
- Time Markers: tomorrow, tonight, next(week, month, year, etc.), (two days, three weeks, 1 month, etc.) from now, when(future event), after(future event/time), within/in (2 days, three weeks, etc.),

EXAMPLESS

- 1. I will meet my friends tonight.
- 2. I am going to play golf this weekend.
- 3. He will be happy when he meets his girlfriend.
- 4. He won't study tomorrow.
- 5. She is going to visit Europe next summer.
- 6. She isn't going to travel alone.
- 7. They won't stop fighting.
- 8. They are going to go fishing when they have free time..
- 9. We aren't going to finish this project on time.
- 10. We will drink after work.
- 11. It is going to rain soon.
- 12. It won't work.
- 13. This movie is going to be exciting.
- 14. This game won't be competitive.
- 15. John is going to be angry when he finds out.
- 16. My friend will come over after he finishes work.
