I like pizza. I like cheesy pizza.

Describing a person:

I like (someone/a person/a guy/a girl) who is... who has...
```

who can...

who does...

whom I am/have/can/do...

Describing a place:

I like (a place) where...

...l can relax.

...we can drink coffee.

...you are.

I like (a place) that...

...is quiet.

...isn't crowded.

...has a swimming pool.

Describing a situation:

I like it when...

...(someone) does/doesn't do something.

...(someone) can/can't do something.

More examples:

I went to a bar that is near my house.

I went to a bar with my friend who likes to drink.

I watched a movie while eating a popcorn that I bought in America.

I play baseball at a park that is is near my house.

I cook food that is healthy for my daughter.

I exercise with weights that aren't too heavy.

I will go to a park where I can relax.

I will study English with my friend whom I have known since middle school.

I will meet someone who has similar interests with me.
