

## Modals of Deduction/Possibility:

### Present:

Must	He must be tired.	(very certain)
May	He may be tired.	
Might/Could	He might be tired.	(less certain)
Can't	He can't be tired.	
May not	He may not be tired.	
Might not	He might not be tired.	
Could not	He couldn't be tired.	

### Past: Have + pp

He ate two bowls of rice. He **must have been** hungry.

She looked a little sad. Her bf **may have broken up** with her.

John didn't want to watch a movie. He **might have had** another plan.

Bobby lost his wallet. He **can't have been** happy.

Sammy couldn't come to class. He **may not have felt** well.

She didn't buy a new dress. She **might not have found** her size.

### Future outcome/possibility:

I will (do)...

I won't (do)...

**I may (do)...**

**I may not (do)...**

**I might (do)...**

**I might not (do)...**

I probably will (do)...

I probably won't (do)...
