New Vocabulary & Expressions

- **Reboot:** A reset or restart, often used to describe restarting something like a computer system or a situation.
 - *"They've rebooted the system again."*
- **Moral Philosophy:** A branch of philosophy that deals with questions about what is morally right and wrong.
 - *"We studied moral philosophy in school."*
- **Paradox:** A situation or statement that contradicts itself or seems to be impossible.
 - *"The idea of a perfect system is a paradox."*

2. How does Eleanor react to the idea of being in the Good Place?
3. What role does Michael play in this new situation?
4. How does Chidi's personality influence the group's decisions?
